Parents, this is a great opportunity to practice leading your families in worship. Here are some things to do before, during, and after Sunday's live stream at 11a. Obviously, the age of your kids will affect how you do this.

Before: Read Hebrews 10:24-25. Explain that the meeting of believers is important. Emphasize that right now, it is still important for us to connect and make sure our families still worship. Pray for the service. Then, review the list below to prepare for the service.

During:

-Do your best to follow along and sing. (Consider looking up the lyrics to these songs ahead of time: *God of Wonders*; *Leaning on the Everlasting Arms*; *Beautiful Lord*; *Give us Clean Hands*.)

-Help your kids find 1 Corinthians 15:12-22.

-Have everyone try to listen for the main idea of the sermon. What is it?

-Have everyone listen for one thing from the message they can apply this week. What is one thing you can do in your life because Christ rose from the dead?

After: Have everyone share their answers to the questions above. Then pray for one another that you'd be able to apply them and help each other apply them.
